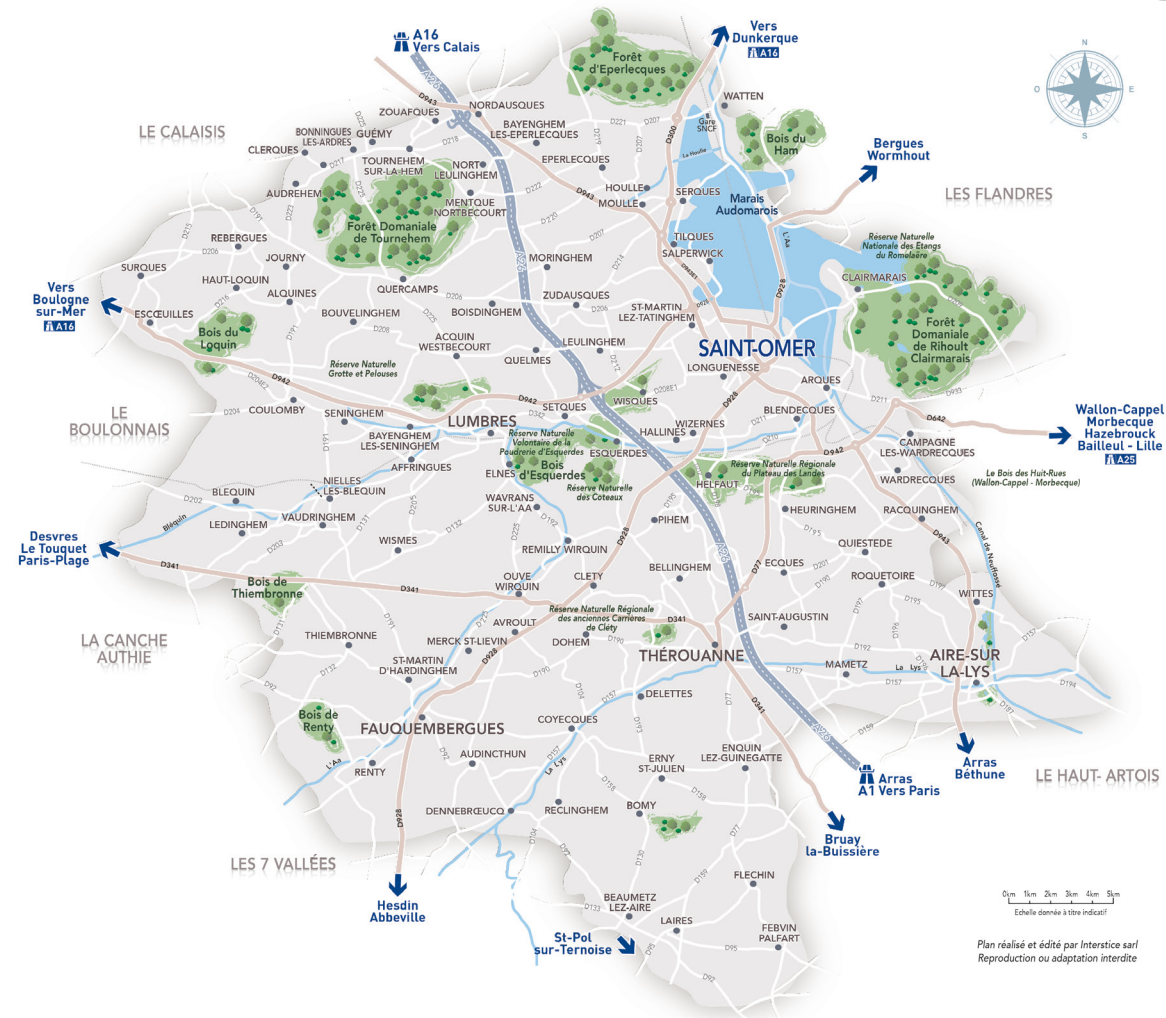
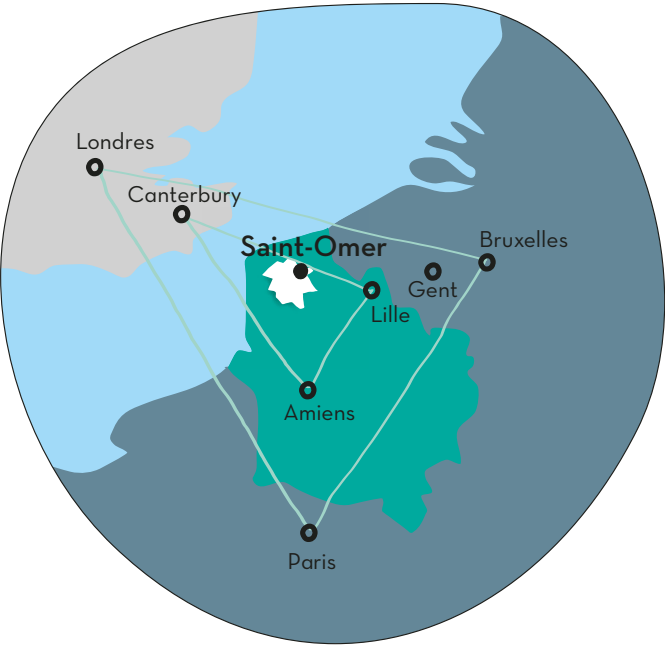

TOWN CENTRE AND MARSHES

- A guided tour of the marshland where you can discover either the nature reserve, the inhabited marshes or the farmed marshes (1 hour)
- 3 course meal including drinks and coffee
- A guided tour of the old town of Saint-Omer and its cathedral. The guide will tell you all about the fortifications, the beautiful city park, the squares and their historical buildings and the shopping streets (2 hours)



REMEMBRANCE AND LEISURE

- On a strange vehicle called Rando-Rail, take a ride in the countryside and the forests of Lumbres in a fun way (1.30 hour)
- 3 course meal including drinks and coffee
- Visit La Coupole, the only dome-shaped bunker in the world that used to be the V2 launch base built by Hitler. Turned into a museum, find out through its exhibitions about the history of the Space Conquest and that of Occupation in Northern France (2 hours).
Don't miss there a 10K-3D planetarium session (1 hour)



CRAFTSMEN'S KNOW-HOW



- Visit one of the only two remaining juniper distillery in France. The Houlle distillery explains all about the making secrets of its precious and rewarded traditional spirit : juniper (1.30 hour).
- 3 course meal including drinks and coffee.
- Discover the workshop of the last traditional marshes wooden boats makers and go for a tour in the marshland aboard one of these special boats, called « bacove » with a guide.

SHORT BREAK - 2 DAYS/ONE NIGHT

DAY 1

- Guided tour of the reknown glass factory Arc France (formerly Arc cristal factory). Through a film and a tour of the installations, discover the glass making secrets. (1.30 + time in the shop).
- 3 course meal including drinks and coffee.
- A guided tour of the marshland where you can discover either the nature reserve, the inhabited marshes or the farmed marshes. (1 hour)
- Visit of the traditional juniper distillery in Houlle including tasting. (1.30 hour)

DAY 2

- Visit of the impressive WW2 bunker of Eperlecques telling the history of V1 and V2 rockets. See there military items and weapons, find out about Deportation and life in the concentration camps. (1.30 hour)
- 3 course meal including drinks and coffee.
- Guided tour of the old town of Saint-Omer and its cathedral (2 hours).
